## **Confidentiality** {kon-fi-den-she-al-i-tee}

• Legal term for when information has to be kept private and not shared with others.

If you are age 14-17 it's UR Right to confidentiality for sexual and mental health care.





All health care providers MUST report to the state if they think you are being abused, neglected, or could hurt yourself or someone else.

- Your provider will let your parent/guardian know if you take certain mental health medications.
- >> Your insurance company may send home information about your health visit.
